Prayer Walking

Following on from our 24-7 prayer room, a pastor of a church in Cusco asked if we could support him in inspiring his church to pray more. We arranged a prayer walk to focus on inviting God's kingdom to come in and around the streets of their church. Although the church had never done anything like this before the leaders and several members of their congregation greeted us with great excitement. Using the 24-& Prayer Walking guide (which, very handily, has been translated into Spanish!) we explained a little bit about the format, split into small groups and headed off.

God spoke powerfully to the groups and individuals as they walked their local streets...

- One group felt called to step into a cafe on the corner of one of the streets & offered prayer to the owner. They felt stirred to start meeting for a coffee here & to continue praying over this area.
- God guided a group they to a bustling park with lots of young people. He spoke to them about starting some outreach youth work here.
- Another group walked past a prison for young people. They were moved to think of ways to reach these young people, to share God's love and bring them hope.

After having a time of prayer together back in the church, sharing all that God had spoken to them about, we left with our spirits lifted high and with such thankful hearts, God had used us in a beautiful way. It was beautiful to see how each person responded to praying in a creative way that was totally new to them. Seeing their excited reactions as they began to hear from God as they walked and talked was inspiring and beautiful.

As a result of this prayer walk, we have been asked to support & guide the church with their first 24-7 Prayer week this coming Sunday (17th July)
