We are forming close friendships due to regular time spent listening to them, encouraging them and speaking about how much Jesus loves them.

One guy has re-committed his life to Jesus and we are supporting him coming off the alcohol and drug issues that have plagued him for many years. This same person is now sharing the gospel and joining us in praying for others on the street.

Another guy who we have connected with shared that he was having family issues and was unable to see his newborn son. So we started to pray together. That next week he started seeing his son at weekends and now sees his son every day. He has also started to build the relationship that was broken with the mother of his child.

We had the honour of leading another young man to Christ last week. He had seen us regularly praying with others and so one day he came up to us and said that he would love to get to know the Jesus we keep talking about.

Another young man, who grew up as an orphan, now lives on his own selling tours on the street. He has some issues with drugs but has often been praying with us and has started coming along to church with us on a Sunday.

These are just some of the lives and situations we are witnessing God's amazing hand at work. So many people we meet are open to prayer and open to gospel conversations. To begin with, the majority of people we meet and pray with ask for God's blessing on their own life and their success with money etc. But over time we are witnessing God working in their hearts and as we encourage their own walks with Jesus, they are starting to pray and intercede for others in a beautiful way.
