Peru Crisis Continues...

Peru is going into it's third month of continued protests, violence, road blocks and general chaos. Over 60 people have been killed so far. Airports have been taken over and closed.

Main roads into Cusco and other cities are blocked by protesters causing homes and businesses to be without gas for cooking and heating. There is no fuel as the tankers can't get through. Prices for food are soaring. Tourism (the main industry) is non existent and has such a knock on effect to the people and families that rely on this. Stronger protests are planned if the government doesn't bring forward elections and the president doesn't stand down. The army are being deployed in the next few days to clear the roadblocks which has potential to be violent.

Please join us in praying for God's supernatural intervention, for peace in the chaos, for resolution and wisdom on leaders and government, and for an end to the suffering of the people.

Prayer Room - Even though we have not started renting or occupying the permanent prayer room due to water and electricity issues, the landlady allowed us to open the room free of charge for several days. This gave the people of the city opportunity to creatively pray for the current situation and their country.
