- The girls have started going to a local school 2 days a week. They are settling in well, enjoying this new experience and lots of new friends.
- Lots of opportunities are opening up for us to be part of City wide conferences and events helping to unite the church and introduce 24-7 Prayer Peru to more people in Cusco.
- As the Peruvian school year starts up we have several 24-7 prayer rooms lined up in different schools.

An area we would really appreciate your prayers for is regarding the permanent prayer room...

We are regrettably having to pull out of the contract and report the landlady to the police for fraud against us. The past 5 months since we signed the contract have been full of deceit, deception and distraction. We have recently found out she has previous convictions for fraud (against past tenants) and a warrant out for her arrest, as well as using several different identities.

Please pray for God's will to be done in the whole situation. We feel that the enemy is getting frustrated with us being here and has therefore put this lady in our path. Please pray for the money to be returned to us. There is a very big chance (due to Peruvian law) that we will not get our deposit of over \$6000 back. Please pray for the landlady and her family as well - so much must have happened in her life for her to reach this point, even though what she is doing is wrong, God still loves her. Please pray for wisdom and favour for us and our lawyer, we are so grateful to have a trustworthy lawyer from our church who is leading and supporting us through this process.

Please know that, through all of this, we are all doing ok and constantly feel God's presence, even though we might not fully understand the why. We feel more determined than ever to move forward and trust God, to praise Him through the trials and to lean deeper into His guidance and love.
